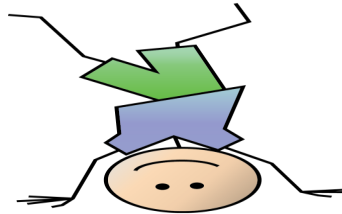

## CHILDHOOD OBESITY AWARENESS MONTH

1 in 3 children in the United States are overweight or obese. Childhood obesity puts kids at risk for health problems that were once seen only in adults, like type 2 diabetes, high blood pressure, and heart disease.

The good news? Childhood obesity can be prevented. Communities, health professionals, and families can work together to create opportunities for kids to eat healthier and get more active.

Make a difference for kids: spread the word about strategies for preventing childhood obesity and encourage communities, organizations, families, and individuals to get involved.

Here are just a few ideas:

Make healthy meals: buy and serve more vegetables, fruits and whole grains.

Encourage families to make small changes, like keeping fresh fruit within reach or going on a family walk after dinner, go on a bike ride or play basketball at the park.

Limit screen time: keep screen time (time spent on computer, TV and video games) to 2 hours a day or less.

Motivate teachers and administrators to make schools healthier. Help them provide healthy food options and

daily physical activities for students.
