## Alcohol Awareness Month

Drinking too much alcohol increases people's risk of injuries, violence, drowning, liver disease, and some types of cancer. This April, during Alcohol Awareness Month, The Marion County Health Department encourages you to educate yourself and your loved ones about the dangers of drinking too much.

While the dangers of drunk driving are well known, inebriated drivers continue to cause massive problems and safety issues on Illinois roadways. According to the 2018 DUI Fact Book published by Illinois Secretary of State, approximately one in every four fatal car accidents throughout the state involved the presence of alcohol. In 2016 alone, there were approximately 272 people fatally injured in car crashes in Illinois involving alcohol.

If you are drinking too much, you can improve your health by cutting back or quitting. Here are some strategies to help you cut back or stop drinking:

- ◆ Limit your drinking to no more than 1 drink a day for women or 2 drinks a day for men.
- ◆ Keep track of how much you drink.
- ◆ Choose a day each week when you will not drink.
- ◆ Don't drink when you are upset.
- ◆ Limit the amount of alcohol you keep at home.
- ◆ Avoid places where people drink a lot.
- ◆ If you are concerned about someone else's drinking, offer to help.
