In the month of May, in observance of National Osteoporosis Month, the Marion County Health Department is offering 25-Hydroxy Vitamin D blood tests at a reduced cost of \$40.00

After your mid 20's, bone thinning is a natural process and cannot be completely stopped. The thicker your bones, the less likely they are to become thin and break. A person may take steps to slow bone thinning and prevent fractures by eating a nutritious diet rich in calcium, maintaining an adequate supply of vitamin D, participating in regular weight-bearing activity and avoiding smoking and limiting alcohol consumption.

99% of the calcium in our bodies is in our bones and teeth. Every day we lose calcium and our bodies cannot produce its own calcium, so this is why it's important to get enough calcium from the foods we eat. Food is the best source of calcium. Dairy products, such as milk, yogurt, and cheese are the richest source of dietary calcium.
