01

Make Prevention a Priority.

Many health conditions can be detected early with regular checkups from your healthcare provider. Regular screenings may include blood pressure, cholesterol, glucose, prostate health and more.

In observance of June being Men's Health Month, the Marion County Health Department is offering a discounted rate for a PSA (Prostate Specific Antigen) lab test. PSA is a substance produced by the prostate gland. Elevated levels may indicate prostate cancer or a non-cancerous condition such as prostatitis or an enlarged prostate.

The Health Department is offering the **PSA non-fasting blood test** at a special rate of **\$25.00** for the month of June.
