# Health Bulletin

The Mission of the Marion County Health Department is to improve the quality of life through preventing disease and preventative health maintenance.



Each year, millions of Americans face the reality of living with a mental health condition. However, mental illness affects everyone directly or indirectly through family, friends, or coworkers. That is why each year, during the first week of October, National Alliance on Mental Health (NAMI) and participants across the country raise awareness of mental illness, fight discrimination and provide support through Mental Awareness Week (MAW).

### Fast Facts:

- ⇒ 1 in 5 U.S. adults experience mental illness each year.
- ⇒ 1 in 20 U.S. adults experience serious mental illness each year.

- ⇒ 1 in 6 U.S. youth aged 6-17 experience a mental health disorder each year.

### Annual prevalence among U.S. adults, by condition:

- ⇒ Anxiety Disorders: 19.1% (estimated 48 million people)
- ⇒ Major Depressive Episode: 7.8% (19.4 million people)
- ⇒ Posttraumatic Stress Disorder: 3.6% (estimated 9 million people)
- ⇒ Bipolar Disorder: 2.8% (estimated 7 million people)

### People suffering from depression often experience some of these key symptoms:

- A persistent sad, anxious or “empty” mood
- Sleeping too little, early morning awakening, or sleeping too much
- Reduced appetite and weight loss, or increased appetite and weight gain
- Loss of interest or pleasure in activities once enjoyed
- Restlessness or irritability

- Difficulty concentrating, remembering or making decisions
- Fatigue or loss of energy
- Thoughts of death or suicide

Taking a mental health screen is one of the quickest and easiest ways to determine whether you are experiencing symptoms of a mental health condition. Screenings are not a professional diagnosis. Screenings point out the presence or absence of depressive symptoms and provide a referral for further evaluation if needed. You should see your doctor or qualified mental health professional if you experience five or more of these symptoms for longer than two weeks or if the symptoms are severe enough to interfere with your daily routine.
