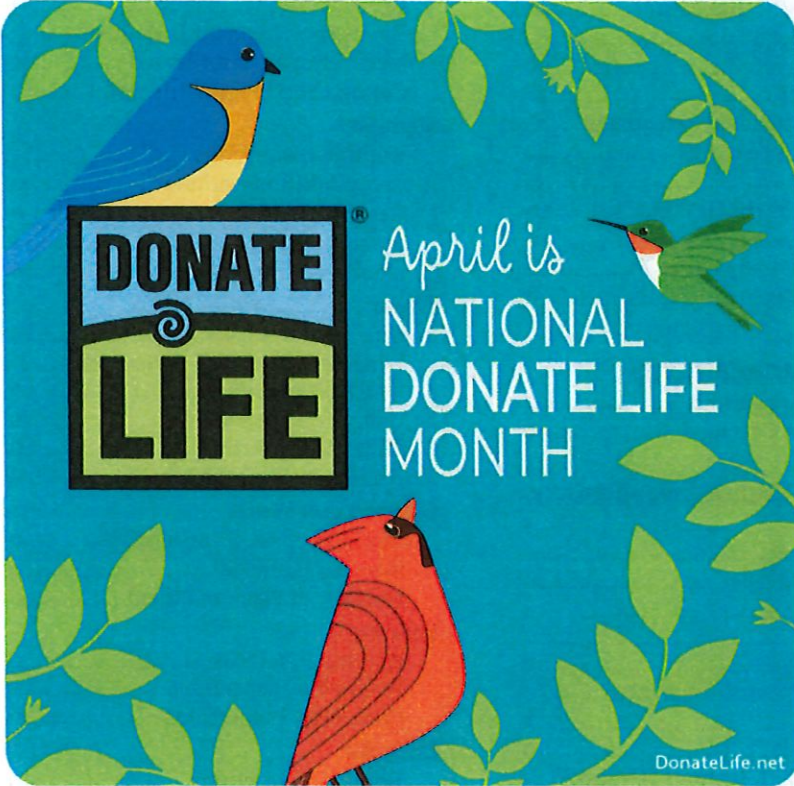

In the United States, more than 100,000 men, women and children are on the national organ transplant waiting list.

Every 8 minutes, a new name is added to the ever-growing transplant wait list. Unfortunately, an average of 17 people die each day waiting for an organ transplant.

ONE person - one registered organ donor - can save up to 8 lives through organ donation, and improve over 75 lives through tissue and cornea donation.

More than 48,000 transplants were performed in 2024. As of September 2024, there were 89,792 patients waiting for a kidney transplant.
