

Employee Health

Any food worker diagnosed with or exposed to the following shall report this to their manager and cannot return to work until authorized by a Health Practitioner or the Health Department:

SEND = Salmonella*
SICK = Shigella
EMPLOYEES = E. coli
HOME = Hepatitis A
NOW = Norovirus

* Nontyphoidal Salmonella and Typhoid fever (Salmonella Typhi)

Any food worker displaying the following symptoms cannot work with or around food for at least 24 hours from the last symptom:

- Vomiting
- Diarrhea
- Sore Throat with a Fever
- Jaundice
- Unprotected & Infected Wounds

Food employees experiencing persistent sneezing, coughing, or a runny nose that causes discharges from the eyes, nose, or mouth **MAY NOT** work with exposed food or in food preparation areas.

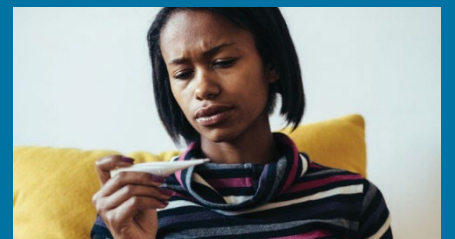

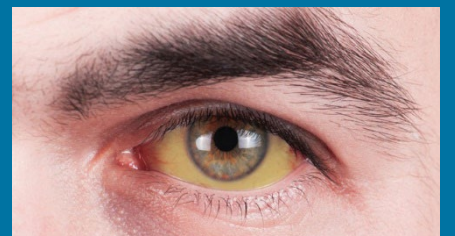
Vomiting
