MEN'S HEALTH MATTERS



June is designated as Men's Health Month, a time to raise awareness and encourage men to prioritize their health, focusing on prevention, early detection, and healthy living habits.

On average, men die about five years earlier than women and have higher mortality rates from some cancers and heart disease, according to the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC). It's important, then, that men talk to their health care providers about what types of preventive medical tests and activities they need to stay healthy.

The American Cancer Society's estimates for prostate cancer in the United States for 2025:

- About 313,780 new cases of prostate cancer
- About 35,770 deaths from prostate cancer

The number of prostate cancers diagnosed each year declined sharply from 2007 to 2014, coinciding with fewer men being screened because of changes in screening recommendations. Since 2014, however, the incidence rate has increased by 3% per year.


A PSA (prostate-specific antigen) blood test measures the levels of a protein produced by the prostate gland, and is used as a screening tool for prostate cancer, though elevated levels can also indicate other prostate conditions.
