Colorectal Cancer Awareness Month

EARLY DETECTION



Colorectal cancer screening should begin at age 45. **Screening is the number one way to prevent colorectal cancer.** Still, a third of eligible adults is not getting screened. In late 2020, the CDC estimated that **68% of colorectal cancer deaths could be prevented if all eligible people were screened.**



A Fecal Immunochemical Test or FIT may be a good option for people aged 45-75 who are resistant to getting a colonoscopy. If interested you may call Marion County Health Department, Salem Office, 618-548-3878, Monday through Friday to receive further information of the **FREE** FIT kits and to be screened over the phone for FIT eligibility.

FAST FACTS:

- Colorectal cancer is a **disease in which cells in the colon or rectum grow out of control.** Sometimes it is called colon cancer, for short.
- In 2024 an estimated 154,270 people will be diagnosed with colorectal cancer in the U.S., and an estimated 53,010 will die - making this disease the **second-leading cause of cancer deaths overall.**
- The average lifetime risk of colorectal cancer is 1 in 24, and a family history of the disease is the strongest risk factor. Most cases are diagnosed in people over age 50.
- Colorectal cancer almost always develops from precancerous polyps (abnormal growths) in the colon or rectum.
- **Screening tests can find precancerous polyps**, so that they can be removed before they turn into cancer. Screening tests can also find colorectal cancer early, when treatment works best.
